



2023 Updates to Yampatika's Camp Scholarship Process

Thank you for your interest in our Camp Scholarship Program. The goal of our camp scholarships is to provide an opportunity for children who might not otherwise be able to participate in camp because of cost, to have the Yampatika camp experience. Our goal is that the money we award through scholarships has the greatest possible impact on local families in need. To ensure that our scholarships continue to have the greatest impact we look at several things when reviewing our scholarship applications. These include annual income, family size, the cost of living in Routt County, and any other situations that may impact an individual's ability to come to camp. We may also work with community partners to nominate individuals that are deserving of financial assistance.

This year we will be prioritizing those applicants who are in the greatest need for scholarships. If you are seeking a scholarship, we encourage you to apply. Please know that even though you have received a scholarship in the past, you may not qualify for one in the future due to the number of needs and limited resources.

Another change this year is that we will be reviewing our scholarships in two rounds:

- Round 1: Open Feb. 6th - Feb. 24th.
 - These scholarship applications will be reviewed and placement will occur before registration opens on March 1st.
- Round 2: Opens March 1st with open registration
 - As in previous years, we will accept scholarship applications once registration is open on a rolling basis until we have depleted our funds or camp is full. While we do reserve a certain number of spots for scholarship recipients, we do not guarantee that all applicants will receive a spot.

Receiving a scholarship does not guarantee a spot in any specific week of camp. Placement of a scholarship recipient depends on preference and availability. You may be asked to join the waitlist if a camp you are interested in is full.
